

Another 100 DAYS of Prayer, Fasting & Advocacy

“As bearers of hope, we commit to live compassion, communion and non-violence as one global community” LCWR Assembly Resolution, 2025-2029

As women religious and LCWR Congregations, we find ourselves in the midst of turbulence, violent rhetoric and action, upheaval of processes we have counted on for generations, and an crises in mental and spiritual health.

Recognizing the Gospel call and our values of contemplation intersected with action, we continue to find ways to deepen our commitment to extended times of silence and prayer, while also using our voices to speak truth with courage.

LCWR has made a serious commitment to this intersection through the public witness of our recurring cycles of 100 Days of Prayer, Fasting and Advocacy.

We have completed two sessions of the 100 Days of Commitment. These 200 days of Prayer, Fasting and Commitment engaged over 200 LCWR Congregations in commitment to silence, learning, dialogue, and advocacy. More than 1,000 letters were hand-delivered to members of Congress on behalf of the sisters of LCWR. These letters communicated the depth of passion women religious have for the LCWR commitments to immigration, human trafficking, racism, care for our climate, and advocacy on behalf of the most vulnerable.
